## Post Intravitreal Injection Information

### Following your injection you may experience some of the following:

- Mild irritation – this will subside after a few days
- Watery eye – this will subside after a few days
- Redness of the eye – this will resolve 5 -10 days after the injection
- Black floaters immediately after the injection – this is due to an air bubble that has been injected and this will disperse over approx 2 days.

### Contact the Eye Care Centre if you experience:

- A reduction in vision
- Pain in the eye with or without headache and nausea
- Black areas of your vision, veil effect, cobweb effect
- Sticky discharge from the eye.

**Eye Drops** – Please instil the eye drops as prescribed this will promote healing at the injection site and reduce the risk of infection.
